



Alaska Land Mobile Radio Information Assurance Awareness Policy

1. Applicability

This policy applies to all employees, contractors, consultants, temporary employees, and other personnel assigned to the Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) Communications System. This policy defines the Information Assurance (IA) standards applied to the ALMR System and by which all member agencies and support personnel shall abide. Any revision or update of this policy must be approved by the User Council.

2. Policy

All data on the System is deemed "For Official Use Only" and shall be treated as "Sensitive But Unclassified." The System Management Office (SMO) shall implement an IA posture which is sufficient to maintain an Authority to Operate, as defined by DIACAP, and determined by the Alaskan Command J6 or DOD Designated Approving Authority. As such, System users shall be knowledgeable of, and comply with, all applicable IA policies and training requirements.

3. Procedures

The ALMR System employs the use of multiple Department of Defense (DOD), Federal and Industry Security guidelines and recommendations, and enforces all IA requirements through applicable policies and procedures, as well as ALMR System configurations, as outlined in Information Assurance Awareness Procedure 200-5.

4. Effective Date

This policy shall become effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded. The policy shall be reviewed periodically and updated, as required.
