



## Alaska Land Mobile Radio Disaster Recovery Policy

### 1. Applicability

This policy applies to all Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) Communications System employees, contractors, consultants, temporary employees, and other assigned personnel. Any revision or update of this policy must be approved by the User Council.

### 2. Policy

In time of disaster, the System Management Office (SMO) shall notify the Disaster Recovery Team of the event, establish a central meeting location for the Disaster Recovery Team, and define required actions for the creation, implementation and management of an appropriate Disaster Recovery Plan using ALMR Disaster Recovery Procedure 400-1.

All personnel with a System user account shall receive annual Information Assurance training defining their disaster recovery responsibilities.


### 3. Procedures

This policy meets or surpasses the minimum accepted level of disaster recovery controls for the ALMR System in the form of technical, operational, and managerial control as required under DODI 8500.2, Information Assurance (IA) Implementation and NIST SP800-53, Recommended Security Controls for Federal Information Systems.

To successfully comply with Information Assurance requirements under the Department of Defense Information Assurance Certification and Accreditation Process (DIACAP), disaster recovery planning should be an integrated part of the user culture. A lack of established controls for disaster recovery exposes the ALMR System to risks including attacks, compromise of network systems and services, legal issues, and potential Denial of Authorization to Operate.

### 4. Effective Date

This policy shall become effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded. The policy shall be reviewed periodically and updated, as required.
