



Alaska Land Mobile Radio Privileged User Acceptable Use Policy

1. Applicability

This policy applies to users of the Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) Communications System deemed as privileged users and to specific members of the ALMR staff. It governs responsibilities pertaining to appropriate safeguarding of the System, the information contained within, and its proper operational use. Any revision or update of this policy must be approved by the User Council.

2. Policy

All users of the ALMR System have the primary responsibility to safeguard information contained in ALMR information systems, which includes preventing unauthorized or inadvertent modification, disclosure, destruction, denial of service, and misuse as outlined in ALMR Privileged User Acceptable Use Procedure 400-7.

3. Procedures

Access to the ALMR network is "For Official Use Only" and set forth by the Department of Defense Information Assurance Certification and Accreditation Process (DIACAP) and in accordance with Department of Defense (DOD) Directive 8500.1, Information Assurance (IA), October 24, 2002, and DOD Instruction 8500.2, Information Assurance (IA) Implementation, February 6, 2003. Access to any ALMR resource is a revocable privilege and is subject to constant monitoring and security testing.

4. Effective Date

This policy shall become effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded. The policy shall be reviewed periodically and updated, as required.
